

2017 GOLD MEDAL JURY CITATION

The World Environment Center Gold Medal Jury is pleased to announce HP Inc. as the 2017 recipient of WEC's Gold Medal for International Corporate Achievement in Sustainable Development. HP was selected in part for its commitment to reduce its global environmental impact, use 100% renewable electricity in global operations, achieve zero deforestation in paper and paper-based products, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions (GHG).

Reflecting the Gold Medal's global focus, HP is also addressing 16 of the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, working toward addressing grand challenges including climate change, gender inequality, dignity of workers, access to quality education and economic opportunity, and clean and affordable energy.
